

It is my great pleasure to offer this *Annual Report* for Theological College covering the 2022–2023 fiscal year. This has been a time of both transition and opportunity for this venerable institution and I am honored to serve as the new rector and to be a part of this important mission.

It is a tremendous privilege for me to share some initial reflections as the incoming rector of Theological College. I was ordained nearly a quarter of a century ago and have been involved, in various capacities, in the ministry of priestly formation. In recent years, the somewhat paradoxical nature of the priesthood is something of which I have grown more aware. On the one hand, the priest is called to represent the eternal and unvarying. In season and out, he must be an effective symbol of Christ's immutable truth and love. On the other hand, this mission must be lived out in specific times and places which are always in a state of flux.

This is the challenge of the priesthood. I would also suggest that in living this tension between time and eternity one's ministry finds its fulfillment. Theological College is committed to the formation of priests who can be powerful witnesses to Christ the Eternal Shepherd in the here and now. The priest of the twenty-first century is called to speak a truth that transcends the ideologies and partisanship that characterize current public discourse. He must be an instrument of reconciliation in a world that is wounded and searching for healing. Above all, the priest must be a sign of hope in a culture that at times appears mired in despair.

It is my heartfelt conviction that Theological College is endowed with precisely those qualities and resources essential for a seminary of this age. Its association with The Catholic University of America provides a solid intellectual

foundation for those called upon to teach and proclaim Christ's Gospel in a culture in which the life of the mind is not always valued. The Archdiocese of Washington provides a rich variety of ministerial placements for men who will be called upon, much sooner than in previous generations of priests, to assume significant pastoral responsibilities. Finally, the Sulpician tradition of human and spiritual formation provides the proper context for configuring the seminarian to the heart, mind, and soul of Jesus Christ the High Priest.


Yes, the challenges are great but by no means insurmountable. Fr. Olier, the founder of the Society of St. Sulpice, never tired of reminding the original members of the company that priestly formation is ultimately the action of Christ and the Holy Spirit and that the task of the teachers and formators is simply to be instruments of what is a divine work.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the donors, alumni, patrons, and all those who make it possible for Theological College to continue its work of forming men into pastors and teachers of the people of God. Your prayers and continued financial support are much appreciated and are clear signs of confidence in our work. Let us remember each other in prayer as we begin what I know will be an extraordinary school year and a new chapter in the history of this seminary.

Mission

Theological College participates in the mission and responsibility of the bishops to provide for the people of God wise and holy priests close to the heart of Christ and consumed in his work of salvation. In affiliation with The Catholic University of America, Theological College assists seminarians in the task of vocational discernment and in the preparation for priestly life and ministry at the diocesan level, particularly as experienced in the United States.

Sulpician Tradition

The formation program of Theological College is guided by the principles and ethos of the Sulpician Fathers as articulated by Father Jean-Jacques Olier, founder of the Society of St. Sulpice: "to live supremely for God in Christ Jesus our Lord, so much so that the inner life of His only Son should penetrate to the inmost depths of our heart and to such an extent that everyone should be able to say, 'It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me.'" Originally founded to reform the clergy in 1630s France, the Society retains its commitment of "developing men of character, educating effective priests, forming pastoral leaders, and nurturing an apostolic spirit."

This new sculpture on TC's front lawn, facing the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception, titled Advent by artist Tim Schmalz, was dedicated as the National Life Monument and blessed by Cardinal Wilton Gregory on May 17. 


